

2017 results

Key Stage 5

Progress in English and Maths

- 72% English GCSE resit students gained a grade C or above (+0.72)
- 66% Maths GCSE resit students gained a grade C or above (+0.66)

Progress made in comparison with students across England

- The Progress Measure for A Level results is +0.18 which is slightly above the national average
- The progress Measure for Applied General qualifications is +0.62 which is above national average

Attainment

- The average grade that students get at 16-19 study (KS5) in A level qualifications is C+ in line with the national average of C+
- The average grade that students get at 16 to 19 study (KS5) in Applied General qualifications is Merit which is below the national average of Distinction.

Retention

- 97% of students enrolled on A Level qualifications in 2015/16 completed their programmes of study in 2016/17
- 100% of students enrolled on Applied General qualifications 2015/16 completed their programmes of study in 2016/17
- 69% of students enrolled in 2015/16 completed their programmes of study in 2016/17

Destinations

- 100% of students continued in education or training or moved into employment at the end of 16 to 19 study in 2017
- 65% of students completing Year 13 in 2016/17 now attend university
- 26% of students completing Year 13 in 2016/17 now attend Russell Group universities
- 27% of students completing Year 13 in 2015/16 are now in employment or apprenticeships
